Collections

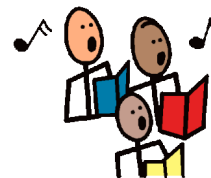
Last week's collection was £1,020.15 of which 40% was Gift Aided

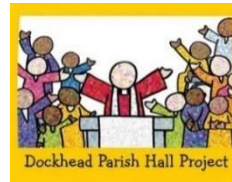
This weekend we welcome very warmly Archbishop John Wilson to our 10am Mass
