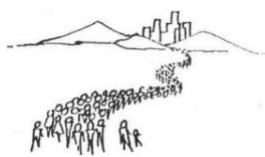

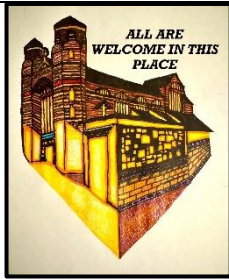
### Our Advent Project raised £3,104.94

## Our Parish Centre Project

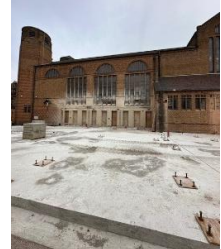

- Using a Contactless machine. We now have four machines available for anyone to make a donation using a debit/credit card for the offertory, second collection, Parish Centre Appeal, or candles - one at each door.

## MAXIMISING YOUR DONATIONS & INCREASING OUR FUNDS

- **GIFT AID** - If you are a tax payer but not already Gift Aiding your donations, please consider signing up so that we can increase our income in the parish without you donating any more money.
- **CONTACTLESS** - If you use the same card, once you select all past and future donations, you do not need to re-enter your full details each time.
- **METHOD OF GIVING** - We are very grateful for whatever method you use. However, if you are making a large donation please speak to us first, as we do get charged fees for some methods. There are no fees if you donate via bank transfer or cash and means that 100% goes into our pot
