OUR PARISH CENTRE AS A BEACON OF HOPE IN BERMONDSEY


Join the conversation: how can our Parish Centre be a Beacon of Hope in Bermondsey?



For Offertory:

- Gift Aid envelopes in the weekly basket.
- Standing order/online donations/bank transfer: *a/c name: RCAS Bermondsey Dockhead; sort code: 60-21-34; a/c no: 35542756*
- Using a Contactless machine. We have four machines available for anyone to make a donation using a debit/credit card for the offertory, second collection, Parish Centre Appeal, or candles - one at each door. If you wish the donation to be gift aided, then use the same card if you can. Then once you select all past and future donations, you do not need to re-enter the full details each time.



- You can also donate using Apple Pay, Google Pay, credit and debit cards by scanning the link to the left or going to <https://tinyurl.com/SupportMHT> . The QR code is also the website - just tap it from your phone to donate.
