When: Thursday 7th May, 7pm

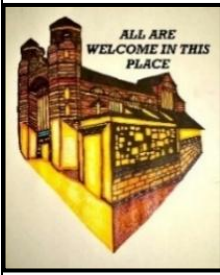

Special thanks to the anonymous donors who contributed a total of £4,500!

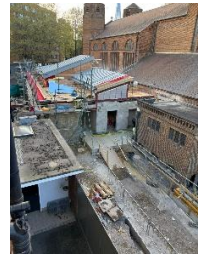
