**When:** Thursday 7th May, 7pm

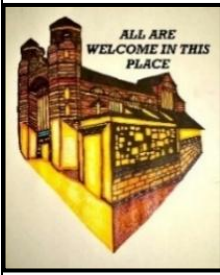
**Where:** Bon Vino 35, 35 Dockhead, SE1 2BS.

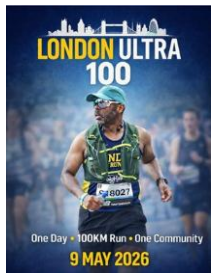
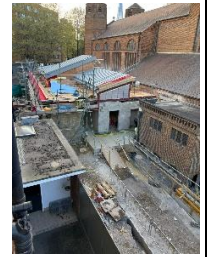
### Parish Centre donations last week totalled £ 507
