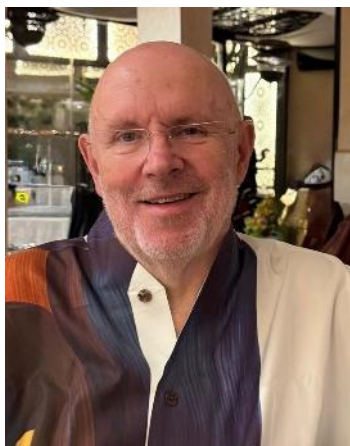
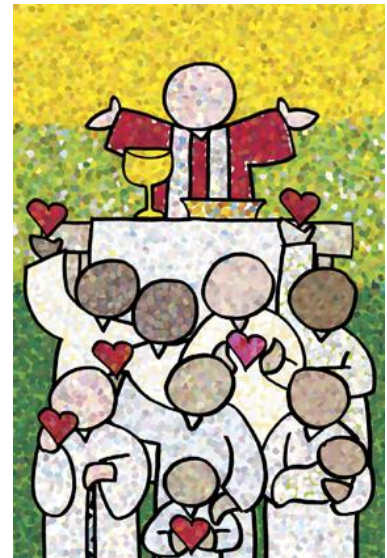

Celebrate your Wedding Anniversary

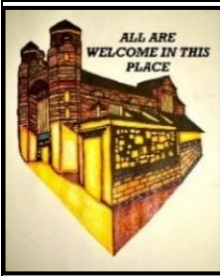

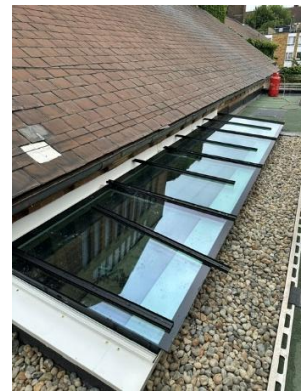
Parish Centre donations and fundraising last week totalled £ 561
