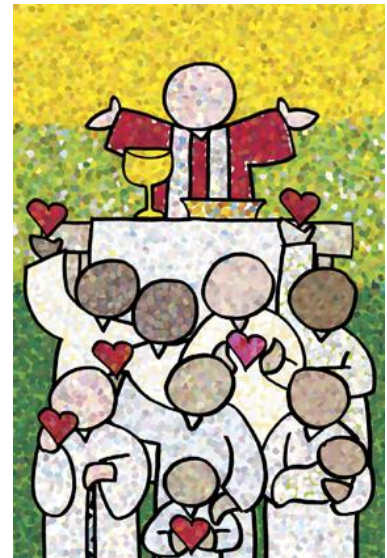

CANON ALAN'S FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS

The reception of Canon Alan's body into the Church will be at 7:30pm on Thursday 2nd July. There will then be a Parish Mass celebrated by Canon Michael Branch and Fr Dermott O'Gorman. Following the mass, the church will be open for private prayer until 9:45pm when there will be Night Prayer before the church is locked.

The funeral will be on Friday, 3rd July at 11am. The main celebrant will be Archbishop John Wilson. We are anticipating a large number of people at the funeral. The funeral will be livestreamed. If you are uncomfortable in large crowds, you may prefer to watch online.

After the mass, the burial will be a private ceremony.

Canon Alan always enjoyed a party. His wish was for as many people as possible to be invited to the reception. We don't yet have a Parish Centre. However, there will be a reception in a marquee that is being erected in Southwark Park from 1:30pm to 4pm. It does have a maximum capacity so will be a ticketed event. If you would like to attend, please ensure you sign up to the sheet at the back of church this weekend. If more people want to attend than we can accommodate, we will draw names from a hat. We will be distributing the tickets at all masses the following weekend.

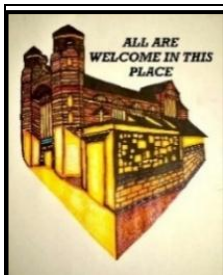
